

## Parkway Animal Hospital Adoption Policy for Cats

I, \_\_\_\_\_, fully agree to uphold the conditions stated herein. I also understand that adopting a pet is a financial commitment as well as an emotional one. Failure to comply with this agreement will result in the immediate return of said animal.

- Cats must be given a **series of vaccines**. The initial series of vaccines begins at 6-8 weeks of age and continues every 3-4 weeks until the animal is 16 weeks of age. They must then be updated once a year. We require that all animals adopted from this clinic receive FVRCP, Feline Leukemia, Rabies, and fecal exam every year. We do not require that it be done here. However we do ask that we be given the name of the vet you will be going to, and ask that you give us a call once a year to ensure that vaccines have been given.
- We require that all pets adopted from Parkway Animal Hospital be **spayed or neutered**.
- If for ANY reason things do not work with the new cat we require they be **returned to us for re - adoption**. This animal MAY NOT be given to anyone other than the adopter. Parkway Animal Hospital will take back a cat for any reason and at any age.
- We, at Parkway Animal Hospital strongly suggest for your new pets safety that they **stay indoors**.
- Parkway Animal Hospital suggests all animals be kept on a **premium diet**, this is especially important for young animals. Please ask us for our recommendations.
- Flea control is another important consideration when adopting a new pet. We will be glad to give you advice on prevention before you take your new animal home.
- Should you need any further instructions on feeding or caring for your new kitten please feel free to give us a call. Please bring your new pet back for visits - we love to watch them grow !
- A \$\_\_\_\_\_ fee is required to help support the rescue and adoption orphanage.
